Thought for the day:

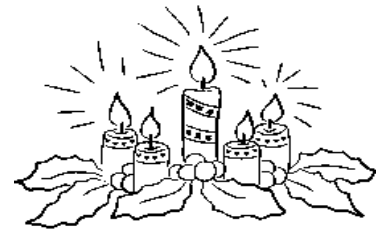
